PROJECTS TO BE UNDERTAKEN FY2014/15

1. **ICT infrastructure** – includes a data centre to host the identified systems and network coverage to all NCC service delivery points including sub-counties and wards.
2. **Integrated County Management System (ICMS)** –Core application to automate the County's business processes and will cover functionalities such as Revenue Management, HR, Procurement, Citizen Services and Specialized departmental functions, Fleet Management, Projects Management, Performance Management and others. The ICMS will be integrated to other applications such as e-Payment, Web Portal and Business Intelligence
3. **Unified Communication** - A reliable solution for collaboration covering telephone PABX and video conferencing.
4. **Internet Service Provision to HQ, Annex, Sub-counties and other key installations**

Project Timelines:-

2. ICMS – 3 Phases covering a period of 5 years after contract award
3. Unified Communication – 6 months after contract award
4. ISP – 30 days (31st August, 2014)
